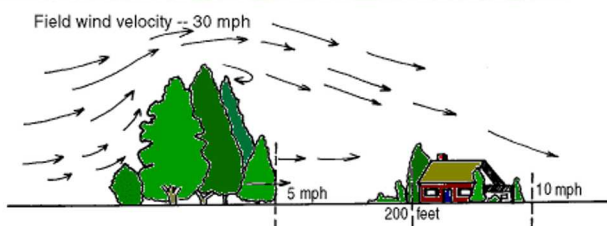

Order season

We will start accepting orders for shrubs and trees for the 2023 planting season in October. Order fulfillment are based on availability, so we encourage purchasing early to guarantee species and size. Please note prices and inventory may be subject to change without notice. Orders will be taken until April 1, 2023. Shipment of trees may be expected by the last week of April 2023 to mid May 2023.

Inventory on Order Form

Conservation shrubs and trees are selected for their suitability for wildlife shelterbelts, windbreaks, pollinator habitat and erosion control; and may not be appropriate for home landscaping projects. Please visit your local nursery for more options. Larger trees that are not able to be shipped may not be available this season due to shipping issues.

When Ordering

Trees come in bundles of 25 for conservation grade (CG) 12-24 " up to 2-3 foot or 10 in a bundle for- 3+ bare-root deciduous. Bareroot conifers are pkg in bundles of 25. Plugs can be purchased individually. Please order in bundles not individually. We will not split bundles for smaller purchases. Check with us on other species not listed. Prices may vary on less common trees.

PRICES: CG-Bare root \$1.75/TREE, 2-3Ft \$2.50/TREE, 3+ \$4.50/TREE Prices subject to change due to shipping and tree costs.

Payment

Payment is due upon receipt of products. Cash or check payments only. Please make checks out to Richland County Conservation District.

Changes to order

Changes to order may be accepted until February 15th of the current year

Cancellation of order

Cancellations to order may be accepted until February 1st of current year..

Tree Pick-up and Warranty

Plants are in a dormant stage and field harvested just prior to shipment. Orders should be picked up as soon as possible after delivery notification. Payment is due upon pickup.

Please note: Although we try to secure the best plants and schedule timely deliveries, plants are a perishable product and therefore, not guaranteed. Replacement and/or refunds will be subject to Conservation District and/or vendor policies.

Planting and mesh laying

The conservation district offers tree planting and fabric laying for shelterbelts, windbreaks and wildlife plantings. We are not able to plant trees in small tight areas due to the size of our machines. Minimum cost for planting trees is \$150 (300 trees or less) 300+ trees \$0.50 /tree. Fabric laying (including fabric) is \$0.48/ foot. This service is subjected to change due to labor issues. Planter and mesh layer maybe available to rent.
